



Georgia Work Ready Achiever of the Month Criteria

Georgia Work Ready Achiever of the Month entries will be evaluated the last week of each month. Applicants remain eligible for the life of the initiative.

Award criteria

1. Must be a clear narrative of at least five sentences
2. Must describe circumstances that led to taking Work Ready assessment
3. Must describe direct benefits that have come from the Work Ready assessment
4. Should highlight plans for ongoing career and/or education development or self-improvement

Submissions will first be evaluated based on criteria number one. Those that meet that requirement will be judged on a five-point scale in each of the remaining three areas. A total of 15 points are available. The person with the highest point total will be named the Georgia Achiever of the Month.

Winners will be notified by Sarah Cannon, MSL Atlanta. They will be asked to participate in a short interview to develop a profile to be used at www.gaworkready.org, to be sent to their local technical college and be used in media outreach as needed. The Governor's Office of Workforce Development (GOWD) requests the Achiever of the Month winner be available to participate in promotion of the initiative.

Winners will receive a \$100 pre-paid card by mail.
